### Reinforcement Learning

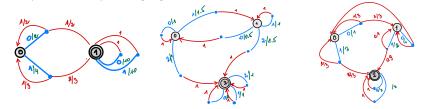
#### Model-Free Reinforcement Learning

#### Presentation

The goal of this lab is to implement model-free reinforcement learning algorithms. We first consider very simple environments and then move to more complex ones.

## Exercice 1.

In this first exercice, you will implement two simple environments. The dynamic of the each environment is described by the corresponding figure.



Create a class Env with the following methods :

- \_\_init\_\_ : the constructor of the class. It should take as input the number of states and the number of actions.
- reset : this method should reset the environment to its initial state.
- play : this method should take as input a state and an action and returns the next state and the reward.

Create three classes Env1, Env2 and Env3 that inherit from the class Env and implement the corresponding dynamic.

#### Exercice 2. (Model-Free Methods)

In this exercice, you will implement differnet model-free reinforcement learning algorithms. For this purpose, you will will create a file model\_free\_agents.py and implement the following agents :

- A class MonteCarlo that implements a Monte Carlo agent.
- A class SARSAAgent that implements a SARSA agent.
- A class QLearningAgent that implements a Q-learning agent.

# Exercice 3. (Application)

In this exercice, you will apply the agents implemented in the previous exercice to the environments implemented in the first exercice.
